The Pilgrimage **price includes** teachings, meditations and Dharma talks from the Plum Village tradition monastics, guide services, transportation, meals, monument entrance fees, bottled water and lodging arrangements for the duration of the pilgrimage.

The tour price includes guide services, transportation, meals, monument entrance fees and bottled water

The Exquisite Caves of Ajanta & Ellora extension (April 21 to April 24, 2024) - US\$ 1695 based on double occupancy. The single room supplement is an additional US\$ 475

The tour price includes guide services, transportation, meals, monument entrance fees, bottled water and lodging arrangements for the duration of the Caves option.

The tour **price includes**: airport transfers and escort services in New Delhi, teaching and guide services, local flights and transportation during the pilgrimage, monument entrance fees, all meals (vegetarian), bottled water and lodging arrangements for the duration of the pilgrimage. All registration fees are payable in U.S. dollars, Euros or the equivalent in another currency.

Please note that **the cost does not cover**: International airfare to and from New Delhi, visas and other international arrangements, any extra days spent in India beyond the dates of the pilgrimage, excess baggage fees on the flights, laundry and medical and other insurance coverage, tips and anything not included in what the 'price includes'. It is advisable that participants purchase Travel Insurance.

The Plum Village monastics will not be accompanying the group to Agra and Aurangabad. We have our excellent experienced guides leading these excursions.

*As the good hotels are limited at the Buddhist sites, and sometimes a few groups arrive on the same day, it may be difficult for hotels to provide a single room, and in some places we may even have triple-sharing for rooms. We ask for your understanding if this circumstance should arise.
